

ADMINISTRATIVE

1) Admission Records

Records pertaining to Admission of students are up to date and maintained as per standard norms. Centralized Admission Process as stipulated by Government of Maharashtra and all rules of every controlling authorities are meticulously followed for admission, similarly Enrolement procedure mandated by Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj (R.T.M.) Nagpur University, Nagpur is regularly complied with and such records properly maintained.

2) Records of Fees and other Dues

Government of Maharashtra has constituted " Shikshan Shulka Samiti" an Authority to monitor and approve the fee structure every year and also to set guideline in this matter. it was observed that PIADS maintains all such records properly following the stipulated norms.

3) Records of Scholarship (if any)

In this matter also mandated / established practices / procedures are properly followed and records are up to date

4) Records pertaining to University

A) Collection and Records of Examination Forms

Rules, regulations, guidelines, schedules, procedures as mandated by R.T.M. Nagpur University are scrupulously followed to maintain records / documents and the same are well maintained and up to date

B) Collection and Records of Examination Fee

In this matter also Rules, regulations, Guidelines, procedures are also scrupulously followed as per directives / norms of R.T.M. Nagpur University and of L.T.J.S.S and all relevant records related to this were found to be in order

4) C) Examination Results and its Records and distribution of Mark - Lists / Degree etc.

Records pertaining to R.T.M. Nagpur University results along with its relevant record and so also of distribution of Mark lists and Degree Certificates are well maintained.

4) D) Distribution of R.T.M. Nagpur University Hall / Admission cards.

The PIADS, over a period has developed a well planned and efficient system in place for effective and timely distribution of Examination Hall / Admission Tickets and its back-up records are maintained in systemic order.

5) Preparation and Display of Time - Table

In this matter also PIADS has developed a well thought out system and the Time - Table is prepared and displayed well in advance at different notice boards for students and so also for teaching staff and the same is also posted on their digital sites. The point worth appreciating is the details and clarity in its formation.

5) A) Teaching load distribution

It was noted that PIADS follows the norms as stipulated by R.T.M. Nagpur University in this matter and in few cases the subject load was above the norms.

6) Preparation, contents, display and follow-up of Academic Calander

In this matter as well, it was observed that the preparation of Academic Calander is regular and timely and its contents cover every academic aspect and various activities pertaining not only to curricular but co-curricular activities as well and this calander is also displayed and communicated for information of not for faculty but for students as well. The follow-up was also proper and timely.

7) Staff Student Ratio

This ratio works out to be about 1 : 9.44

8) Mentor Mentee System and its Ratio - Adequacy and Effectiveness

PIADS over a period, seems to have developed a very striking and effective system of Mentor Mentee which was found to be functioning very effectively and producing desirable out-put.

INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS : -

9) A) Time Table / Scheduling

It was noted that in each semester at least two tests were planned and carried out. The scheduling for the same was undertaken well in advance and properly displayed / communicated both to students and faculty.

9) B) Setting of Question Papers and Answer Sheets Assessment

The concerned teacher sets / prepares the Question Papers which were found to be in sync with University Question Papers. The students are issued printed answer sheets of adequate pages. It was noted that in majority of cases the answer sheets assessment was completed in period of 7-8 days and the marks displayed / communicated to students simultaneously.

9) C) System / methods adopted - is it in sync with norms of controlling authorities.

For Internal Examination as well for various assignments the PIADS works in conformity to the set norms of the R.T.M. Nagpur University

10) Analysis of University Examination Results - suggested actions and its implementation.

It was noted that PIADS, in this matter also has evolved a well established method and the results of every subject at the end of every semester are analysed regularly and immediately after declaration by University and the resulting assessment is discussed during "Pedagogy Workshop" and actions are debated and finalised and implemented accordingly.

11) ATTENDANCE RECORDS

A) For Teaching, Non-teaching Staff.

For this purpose E.R.P. system is in force since 8-9 years and the records are well maintained.

12) LEAVE RECORDS

A) For Teaching, Non - teaching Staff

For this purpose also E.R.P. system is in place and has well developed online records which is planned to record date of application, sanction and balance leave etc.

B) For Students

Every class teacher manually maintaining the leave applications of students for their respective class. The records are systematic and properly maintained and leaves to students are regulated as per set norms of the Institution.

13) Teachers Evaluation - Procedure, follow-up

There exists a well developed and established system in this matter of Teachers Evaluation in which every semester students feedback is taken / recorded for each and every faculty subject wise. In this matter the Lokmanya Tilak Jankalyan Shikshan Sansitha (LTJSS) the parent body has evolved a highly developed systems / methodology under which evaluation of each and every teacher is carried out as a centralized process and programme. The collected feedback is methodically evaluated and the resulting out - come /results are communicated to every teacher along with necessary guidelines, comments and cautions where necessary.

14) Monitoring Academic Progress

In this matter also LTJSS the parent body has evolved a well formulated reporting procedure under which PIADS has to submit at an interval of every fortnight the academic / teaching progress of each and every subject to Dean Academics LTJSS. We noted that PIADS practices punctuality in this matter.

15) Seminars / Workshops / Training Programmes / Conferences

The PIADS has well established policy to assist, encourage, promote the faculty in attending / participating / contributing / organising these activities

16) Medical facilities / Financial Support

Presently PIADS lacks in this aspect.

17) LIBRARY

A) Seating Arrangement : - Continues to be inadequate and Needs Improvement.

B) Accession and Maintenance of Records

Was found to be well maintained and regularly up dated

C) System of Stacking / Storing

Is adequate - but need to be updated as per current trends

D) Methods for Recording Students / faculty visiting

This is done manually and for the purpose proper Registers are there which are well maintained and up to date.

E) E - Library

It was noted that PIADS subscribes for adequate number of E-Journals and the same are available online for reference to students and faculty.

F) Methods followed Manual / Digital

Is manual - it is suggested to update this to Digital on the earliest.

G) i) Average number of students visiting library on a working day

40-50

ii) Average number of teachers visiting library on a working day

10-15

iii) Average number of staff and students of other institutes visiting library in a month

5-6

H) Number of Books, Journals, Magazines added in the year. Are they as per suggested / mandated norms.

PIADS Library houses adequate number of Books, Journals, Magazines and additions are also done regularly and all this was as per norms.

I) Involvement of Faculty and Teachers in procurement system of Books / Magazines / Journals

It was observe that PIADS does follow a proper system whereby Staff and Students involvement was noticed where in due preference was given to both Staff and Students.

J) Systems for Management / Control

The KOHA system is installed for management of Library.

K) Number of Staff

- i) Adequate number of staff as per norms of Council of Architecture - New Delhi
- ii) 90% of faculty employed has the required qualification / experience

L) Working Hours - Its suitability

On enquiries it was noted that both student and staff are satisfied with the existing working hours of library. It was also noted these hours are extended as and when so demanded by student community.

18) INFRASTRUCTURE

A) Adequacy

The infrastructure is more than adequate than the stipulated norms.

B) Furniture / Accessories - Adequacy, Maintenance, Upkeep

The studios, Class Rooms, Audio Visual Rooms, common facilities are adequately equipped with necessary furniture and accessories and there is a separate dedicated agency. Looking after the maintenance and day to day cleanliness and upkeep.

This aspect is well looked after.

C) Computer Labs, Furniture / accessories - Adequacy, Maintenance and upkeep

Same observations as for 18) B) above

D) Material Labs - Furniture / accessories - Adequacy, Maintenance and upkeep

Maintenance and upkeep is adequate, however need to work on improving the furniture, accessories and system of display.

E) Toilet Facilities

PIADS has adequate Toilet facility for both Male and Female staff members as well as for students and a Toilet for physically Challenged. All facilities in Toilets are up to date and the upkeep is done every day at frequent intervals - Are well maintained.

F) Staff Room(s)

Staff Rooms are also well furnished, equipped and regularly maintained with day to day upkeep and cleanliness.

G) Drinking Water Arrangements

Adequately provided and ideally located, found them in proper working conditions and are well maintained.

H) Canteen

PIADS has a good, well maintained canteen with adequate furniture and both staff and students seems to be satisfied with the existing arrangements and its menu etc.

I) Parking Facilities

PIADS has more than adequate area for parking of both two and four Wheelers and adequate number of security staff is employed to regulate the same and area is well maintained.

J) Electrical installations and accessories

All studios, Class Rooms, Staff Rooms, Library and all other spaces are fitted with adequate number of Lamps, fans which are in working condition and their maintenance and upkeep seems to be done regularly.

K) Common Facilities

There is adequacy of common facilities both for staff and students and the same are property and regularly maintained.

L) Exhibition / Display Area / spaces

PIADS has a Permanent Exhibition hall and is adequately equipped with all accessories and display arrangements. All such arrangements were found to be well maintained with proper upkeep.

M) PIADS also has adequate and well thought and organised display arrangement for notices and other information both for students and staff and their upkeep is orderly.

19) TEACHING AIDS / EQUIPMENTS / PROVISIONS

PIADS is well equipped with teaching aids such as L.C.D. projectors, Screens, Audio video facility, T.V. etc and the same are property and regularly maintained.

20) Faculty Evaluation - Procedure / Performance

PIADS has a well established students feed back system as well also practices "Staff's Self Appraisal". It was observed that this system has been functioning well with encouraging outcome.

21) Training & Placement

PIADS over few years developed a well connected system for placement and well known Architectural / Interior designing firms regularly visit PIADS for Placement.

Training is an integral mandated requirement of the curriculum and accordingly every student undergoes this mandatory training with practicing Architects for a complete duration of 8th and 9th Semester. The same is followed up by University Viva-voce examination.

22) Co-curricular Activities

i) PIADS on regular basis once in a year organises / conducts Study Tours for each and every student which is in sync with their academic programmes. Similarly PIADS conducts / organises Workshops, Seminars, Competitions, "Hand-ON" activities for students of all semester as well as students are encouraged to participate in all such and similar programmes organised by R.T.M. Nagpur University.

ii) Every year students very actively participate in National level activity organised by National Association of students of Architecture (NASA).

iii) Student's council every year conducts 'AURA' a socio-cultural programme totally managed by students and seems to be working very well with students.

23) Site visits/ Hands - On activities

As a regular and well established practice students are taken to various construction sites, factories to get first hand exposure and are also encouraged to undertake Hands - On activities to explore various materials and design probabilities, usually conducted as Construction Yard activity.

24) It was also noted that the classes and studios are conducted regularly in tune with Time Table and the checking of assignments is also done meticulously and regularly.

There is a set procedure for allotting training to eight and ninth semester students. College also organizes placement program by inviting various organization / architectural firms to institute.

The Institute actively organize Co-curricular activities for students such as workshops, seminars, educational tours, competitions etc. and also encourages students to participate in all such activities conducted by Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University and Professional Bodies.

Students are taken to different sites under construction for practical exposure in various subjects such as, design, construction, building services etc.


